appears to have married a Nancy Finnell/Fennell in Garrard County about 1806. (I'd have to look this up,

if you think he sounds familiar).

The second, William Brown Guthrie married a Polly Crawford in Mercer County (one county west from

Garrard), in 1809. William Brown Guthrie, with his parents and siblings, lived in Garrard (Paint Lick)

just before this time. There are also Crawfords in that neighborhood at that time. Polly's father was a

James Crawford. Perhaps he (James) was your James' son or uncle.

Because neither of these is my direct ancestor, I haven't looked much at the Crawfords, but it was a

curiosity for me.

I am going to Garrard County next month, and on my list of things to do is to copy the marriage bonds for

the Crawfords -- at least those around that time frame.

I'll be happy to share the results with you if you think it will help.
