## Descendancy Narrative of James Crawford (222)

James<sup>1</sup> Crawford (222) was born on 17 Apr 1772.<sup>1,2,3</sup> He married Sarah Smith (1446), daughter of Mary (--?--) (1445), on 2 Sep 1799 at Garrard, Kentucky.<sup>4,5,6</sup> He was member the first church of Eaton called "the old Public Church" circa 1810 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>7</sup> He registered a stock mark in 1811 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>8</sup> Twenty men volunteered for service in War of 1812 including James Crawford (222) at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>9</sup> He and William David Sellers (5314) filed land entry papers indicating full payment for the NW 1/4 S14 T7 Range2E on 11 Sep 1813 at Ohio.<sup>10</sup> He voted in first election in 1814 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>11</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1820 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as James Crawford, His household contained 1 male 10-16, 1 male 45 and over, 1 female under 10, 2 females 10-16, 2 females 16-26, 2 females 45 and over.<sup>12</sup> He purchased land being the W 1/2 NW 1/4 S14 T7 R2E to be divided by a north and south line equally for \$300 from William David Sellers (5314) on 11 Dec 1821 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>13</sup> He sold land to William David Sellers (5314) of Preble County Ohio, being the E 1/2 NW 1/4 S14 T7 R2E for \$300 on 11 Dec 1821 at Preble County, Ohio.14 He was listed on the tax rolls from 1827 to 1850 at Gasper Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>15</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1830 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as James Crawford. His household contained 1 male 20-30, 1 male 50-60, 1 female 15-20, 1 female 20-30, and 1 female 50-60.<sup>16</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1840 at Gasper Township, Preble County, Ohio, as James Crawford. His household contained 1 male 5-10, 1 male 10-15, 1 male 60-70, 1 female under 5, 1 female 15-20 and 1 female 70-80.17 He is head of household on the census of 2 Aug 1850 at Gasper Twp., Gasper Township, Preble County, Ohio, as James Crawford, 78 year old white male farmer born VA with \$2000 in real estate. Enumerated with were Sarah Smith (1446) and Martha Jane Stoner (952).<sup>18</sup> He bequethed \$50 to his grandaughter Mary Ann Stoner (747).<sup>19,20,21</sup> He beguethed \$50 to his granddaughter Martha Jane Stoner (952).<sup>22,23</sup> He died on 5 Jul 1854 at Preble County, Ohio, at age 82.<sup>24,25,26</sup> He was buried after 5 Jul 1854 at Mound Hill, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>27</sup>

**1** Polly<sup>2</sup> Crawford (981) was born after 1799 at KY or OH. She married John Stoner (923) on 18 Jan 1821 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>28,29,30,31</sup>.

**11** Mary Ann<sup>3</sup> Stoner (747).<sup>32,33</sup> She was born on 16 May 1823 at Ohio.<sup>34</sup> She married Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on 30 May 1847 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>35,36,37</sup> She was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 2 Aug 1850 at Gasper Twp., Gasper Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Mary A. Weikle a 27 year old white female born Ohio.<sup>38</sup> She bequethed \$50 to his grandaughter James Crawford (222).<sup>39,40,41</sup> She was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 16 Jul 1860 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as Mary A Wikle a 37 year old female born Ohio.<sup>42</sup> She was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as Mary Ann Wikel a 47 year old female born Ohio.<sup>43</sup> She died on 14 May 1901 at age 77.<sup>44</sup> She was buried after 14 May 1901 at Musselman Cemetery, Camden, Indiana.<sup>45</sup>

**111** Matilda<sup>4</sup> Wikle (1006)<sup>46,47</sup> was born circa 1845 at Ohio.<sup>48</sup> She was enumerated with

Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 2 Aug 1850 at Gasper Twp., Gasper Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Matilda Weikle a 5 year old white female born Ohio.<sup>49</sup> She was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 16 Jul 1860 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as Matilda S. Wikle a 15 year old female born Ohio.<sup>50</sup>

**112** Maria<sup>4</sup> Wikle (997)<sup>51,52</sup> was born circa 1848 at Ohio.<sup>53</sup> She was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 2 Aug 1850 at Gasper Twp., Gasper Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Maria Weikle a 2 year old white female born Ohio.<sup>54</sup> She was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 16 Jul 1860 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as Maria E. Wikle a 12 year old female bornOhio.<sup>55</sup>

**113** William N.<sup>4</sup> Wikle (1327)<sup>56,57</sup> was born circa 1851 at Ohio.<sup>58</sup> He was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 16 Jul 1860 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as William N. Wikle a 9 year old male born Ohio.<sup>59</sup> He was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as William Wikle a 19 year old male born Ohio.<sup>60</sup>

**114** James S.<sup>4</sup> Wikle (1328)<sup>61,62</sup> was born circa 1853 at Indiana.<sup>63</sup> He was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 16 Jul 1860 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as James S. Wikle a 7 year old male born Indiana.<sup>64</sup> He was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as James L. Wikel a 17 year old male born Indiana.<sup>65</sup>

**115** Daniel W.<sup>4</sup> Wikle (1329)<sup>66,67</sup> was born circa 1858 at Indiana.<sup>68</sup> He was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 16 Jul 1860 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as Daniel W. Wikle a 2 year old male born Indiana.<sup>69</sup> He was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as Daniel W. Wikle as Daniel W. Wikel a 13 year old male born Indiana.<sup>70</sup>

**116** Martha J.<sup>4</sup> Wikle (7639)<sup>71,72,73</sup> was born circa 1860 at Indiana.<sup>74</sup> She was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as Martha J. Wikel a 10 year old female born Indiana.<sup>75</sup>

**117** Jacob A.<sup>4</sup> Wikle (7640)<sup>76,77,78</sup> was born circa 1865 at Indiana.<sup>79</sup> He was enumerated with Martha J. Wikle (7639) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Jefferson Township, Jay County, Indiana, listed as Jacob A. Wikel a 5 year old male born Indiana.<sup>80</sup>

**12** Susan<sup>3</sup> Stoner (1000)<sup>81</sup> was born circa 1834 at Ohio.<sup>82</sup> She was enumerated with Jacob Franklin Wikle (927) on the census of 2 Aug 1850 at Gasper Twp., Gasper Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Susan Stover a 16 year old white female born Ohio.<sup>83</sup> She married George Witters (6365) on 23 Sep 1854 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>84</sup> .<sup>85</sup>

**13** Martha Jane<sup>3</sup> Stoner (952).<sup>86</sup> She was born circa 1837 at Ohio.<sup>87</sup> She was enumerated

with James Crawford (222) on the census of 2 Aug 1850 at Gasper Twp., Gasper Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Martha Stover a 13 year old white female born OH.<sup>88</sup> She bequethed \$50 to his granddaughter James Crawford (222).<sup>89,90</sup> She married Jonathan Sheffer (1272) on 27 Mar 1862 at Preble County, Ohio; married by Rev. James Neal.<sup>91,92</sup> She was enumerated with Jonathan Sheffer (1272) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Martha Shaffer a 33 year old female born Ohio.<sup>93</sup>

**131** Emma<sup>4</sup> Shaffer (1273)<sup>94,95</sup> was born circa 1864 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>96</sup> She was enumerated with Jonathan Sheffer (1272) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Emma Shaffer a 6 year old female born Ohio.<sup>97</sup>

**132** Albert F.<sup>4</sup> Shaffer (1274)<sup>98,99</sup> was born circa 1866 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>100</sup> He was enumerated with Jonathan Sheffer (1272) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Albert F. Shaffer a 4 year old male born Ohio.<sup>101</sup>

**133** Laura A.<sup>4</sup> Shaffer (1275)<sup>102,103</sup> was born circa 1869 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>104</sup> She was enumerated with Jonathan Sheffer (1272) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Laura A. Shaffer a 1 year old female born Ohio.<sup>105</sup>

**134** Charles E.<sup>4</sup> Sheffer (6367)<sup>106,107,108</sup> was born in May 1870 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>109</sup>

**2** Nelson G.<sup>2</sup> Crawford (202)<sup>110,111,112</sup> was born on 17 Oct 1808 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>113,114</sup> He was farmer. He purchased 80 acres for \$1.25 per acre (entry #11152) on 18 May 1830 at W 1/2 NW 1/4 S8 T21N R8W, Indiana.<sup>115</sup> He purchased the NW Section 8 Township 21N Range 8 West (80 acres) on 18 May 1830 at Warren Co., Indiana.<sup>116</sup> He resided on 18 May 1830 at Warren Co., Indiana.<sup>117</sup> He was listed on the tax rolls in 1832 at Gasper Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>118</sup> He married Martha Smith (203), daughter of (--?--) Smith (5534) and Hannah (--?--) (5533), on 3 Sep 1833 at Warren Co., Indiana.<sup>119,120,121,122</sup> He resided in 1836 at Washington Township, Warren County, Indiana.<sup>123</sup> He and Martha Smith (203) sold SE1/4 NE1/4 S35T22R9 to Henry Hall for \$100.50 on 28 Dec 1836 at Warren Co., Indiana.<sup>124</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1840 at Warren County, Indiana, as Nelson G. Crawford, with 2 males under 5, 1 male 5-10, 1 male 30-40, 2 females under 5 and 1 female 20-30.<sup>125</sup>

Nelson G. Crawford (202) is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1850 at Washington Twp., Warren Co., Indiana, as Nelson G. Crawford, a 41 year old farmer born Ohio with \$2500 in real estate. Enumerated with were Martha Smith (203), James H. Crawford (204), William C. Crawford (205), Washington Marion Crawford (193), Mary Elizabeth Crawford (206), and Sarah Amanda Crawford (207).<sup>126</sup> He and Martha Smith (203) sold W1/2NW1/4 S24T22NR10W containing 80 acres for \$1000 on 19 Oct 1859 at Warren Co., Indiana, Washington M. Crawford of Warren County, Indiana.<sup>127</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1860 at Pike Twp., Warren Co., Indiana, as N. G. Crawford, a 51 year old farmer born O with \$8000 in real estate. Enumerated with were Martha Smith (203), Sarah Amanda Crawford (207), and Celia Carrie Crawford (208).<sup>128</sup> He witnessed the probate of the estate of William C. Crawford (205) on 16 Nov 1860 at Warren County, Indiana.<sup>129</sup> He died on 21 Mar 1864 at Warren Co., Indiana, at age 55.<sup>130,131</sup> He was buried after 21 Mar 1864 at West Lebanon Cemetery, West Lebanon, Warren Co., Indiana.<sup>132</sup> His estate was probated on 22 Jun 1865 at Warren County, Indiana.

21 James H.<sup>3</sup> Crawford (204)<sup>135,136</sup> was born on 19 Jun 1834 at Warren, Indiana. He was enumerated with Nelson G. Crawford (202) on the census of 1 Jul 1850 at Washington Twp., Warren Co., Indiana, listed as James Crawford a 16 year old male farmer born Ind.<sup>137</sup> He married Eliza Jane Swisher (340), daughter of John Swisher (5658) and Amelia Wright (5659), on 10 Apr 1856 at Indiana.<sup>138,139,140,141</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1860 at Liberty Twp., Warren Co., Indiana, as James H. Crawford, a 25 year old farmer born Ind with \$2400 in real estate. Enumerated with were Eliza Jane Swisher (340), William N. Crawford (211), and John Edgar Crawford (212).<sup>142</sup> He administered the probate of the estate of William C. Crawford (205) on 16 Nov 1860 at Warren County, Indiana.<sup>143</sup> He served Co. F 72nd Regiment Indiana Infantry as scout and assistant wagon master between 1861 and 1865.<sup>144,145</sup> He received a beguest from the estate of Nelson G. Crawford (202) on 22 Jun 1865 at Warren County, Indiana.<sup>146</sup> He witnessed the appointment of Martha Smith (203) as guardian of Celia Carrie Crawford (208) on 27 Oct 1868 at Warren County, Indiana.<sup>147</sup> He is head of household on the census of 22 Jun 1870 at Washington Twp., Warren Co., Indiana, as James Crawford, a 36 year old white male farmer born IN with \$16,100 in real estate and \$3000 in personal property. Enumerated with were Eliza Jane Swisher (340), William N. Crawford (211), John Edgar Crawford (212), Abraham Lincoln Crawford (213), and Ada Jane "Jennie" Crawford (479).<sup>148</sup> He and Martha Smith (203) were executor of the will of Martha Smith (203) on 16 Aug 1871 at Warren County, Indiana.<sup>149</sup> He and Washington Marion Crawford (193) were appointed as guardian of Celia C. Crawford on 13 Oct 1871 at Warren County, Indiana.<sup>150</sup> He witnessed the probate of the estate of Martha Smith (203) in May 1872 at Warren County, Indiana.<sup>151</sup> In Feb 1878, James H. Crawford (204) of at West Lebanon, Warren County, Indiana, loaded freight for move to Kansas.<sup>152</sup> He and his wife and six children arrived in Feb 1878 Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas, with the West Lebanon colony.<sup>153,154,155</sup> He was the member of Methodist Church when it first organized in at Dodge City, Ford County, Kansas, 4 Aug 1878.<sup>156</sup> He was member Union Class of Methodist Church in 1878 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>157</sup> He is head of household on the census of 9 Jun 1880 at Dodge Twp., Ford Co., Kansas, as James Crawford, a 45 year old white male farmer born IN. Enumerated with were Eliza Jane Swisher (340), William N. Crawford (211), John Edgar Crawford (212), Abraham Lincoln Crawford (213), Ada Jane "Jennie" Crawford (479), Henry Clay Crawford (215), and Clara V. Crawford (214).<sup>158</sup> He purchased lot 1 and 2 and S1/2 NE 1/4 Sec 37, Twp 27 R25W being 159 90/100 acres for \$400 from Oliver Marsh on 11 Mar 1882 at Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>159</sup> He and other trusteees ME church purchased lots 7 & 8 Block 18 for \$200 for use by church as place of worship on 11 Oct 1882 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>160</sup> He purchased lot 37 and 39 block 2 Military Avenue from Janah Tulles on 2 Mar 1883 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>161</sup> He had a span of horses stolen from his place south of the river circa 7 Jun 1883 at Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>162</sup> He was was a member of reception committee for 4th of July Knights of Pythias Grand Ball on 28 Jun 1883 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>163</sup> He was visited by Selah Morse, a merchant, from Pike County, Illinois on 26 Jul 1883 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>164</sup> He purchased lots 7 & 8 and E 1/2 SE 1/4 Sect 35 Twp 26 R25W being 165 acres for \$4,300 from Geo W. Reighard with mortgate of \$1500 due 1 June 1887 on 5 Sep 1883 at Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>165</sup> He was a member of group calling for county convention to nominate county ticket.<sup>166</sup> He attended soldiers reunion on 18 Oct 1883 at Leavenworth, Leavenworth Co., Kansas.<sup>167</sup> He was rancher with range on Arkansas River opposite Dodge City on 1 Jan 1884 at Ford Co., Kansas, His cattle brand was an RS on left side smooth crop and small hole in left ear.<sup>168</sup> He was on the Republican ticket for treasurer of Dodge Twp.,

Ford Co., Kansas, on 31 Jan 1884.<sup>169</sup> He purchased lots 21,22,23 & 24 of Block 3 Chestnut for \$900 on 18 Feb 1884 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>170</sup> He purchased the second lot north of the Wright House and will erect a large building for a grocery store on 21 Feb 1884 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>171</sup> He attended annual conference of M.E. Church as lay delegate 12 Mar 1884 Newton, Harvey Co., Kansas.<sup>172</sup> He had a store on Front Street at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas, before 3 Apr 1884. He was owner of the Indiana Grocery located north of the Wright house (on 2nd Ave.) in May 1884 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>173,174</sup> He established a general merchandise store at Belle Meade, Kansas, on 10 Jul 1884.<sup>175</sup> He owned branding corral one mile south of Arkansas River at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas, on 10 Jul 1884.<sup>176</sup> He was appointed viewer of road petitioned by David Morrow on 10 Jul 1884 at Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>177</sup> He was listed on the delinquent tax rolls for 1883 taxes on 24 Jul 1884 at Dodge Twp., Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>178</sup> He operated the South Side Hotel on 24 Jul 1884 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>179</sup> He visited Indiana on 4 Sep 1884.<sup>180</sup> He was breeder of thoroughbred Essex and Berkshire hogs on 23 Dec 1884 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>181</sup> He visited Sterling, Colorado, circa 4 Apr 1885.<sup>182</sup> He purchased Lot 6 and S 1/2 SW 1/4 Sect 35 T26S R25W for \$1100 from L. B. Armstrong on 1 May 1885 at Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>183</sup> He has 40 breeding sows and 3 fine boars all of the Poland China and Essex breed on 2 Jun 1885 at Ford Co., Colorado.<sup>184</sup> He visited Kansas City circa 8 Jul 1885.<sup>185</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1885 at Ford Co., Kansas, as J. H. Crawford, a 50 year old white male merchant born Indiana who served in Company F of the 72nd Regiment of the Indiana Infantry during the civil war. Enumerated with were Eliza Jane Swisher (340), William N. Crawford (211), John Edgar Crawford (212), Abraham Lincoln Crawford (213), Ada Jane "Jennie" Crawford (479), Henry Clay Crawford (215), and Clara V. Crawford (214).<sup>186</sup> He, grocery man, added a new delivery wagon and delivers groceries to all parts of at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas, on 16 Jul 1885.<sup>187</sup> He visited (an unknown value) West Baden Springs, Orange Co., Indiana, on 13 Aug 1885.188 He has plattted 119 acres of land south of the Arkansas River bridge into one acre lots to be known as J. H. Crawford's subdivision on 24 Sep 1885 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>189</sup> He purchased Lot #6 & 7 in block 47 on 19 Dec 1885 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas, Dodge City Town Company.<sup>190</sup> He was attended the wedding of O. S. Baily and Miss Maud Vancil along with Mr. and Mrs. G. W. Stover and Mr. and Mrs. Frank Stover of Pulaski, Iowa before 4 Feb 1886 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>191</sup> He was stockholder of Monarch Mortgage and Loand Company on 11 Feb 1886 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>192</sup> He was appointed director at organizational meeting of Merchant's State Bank on 18 Feb 1886 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>193</sup> He and Eliza Jane Swisher (340) attended conference of the ME Church circa 16 Mar 1886 McPherson, Kansas. James H. Crawford (204) goas as a delegate from Dodge City.<sup>194</sup> He attended the silver wedding celebration of Mr. and Mrs. R. P. Adams at Ly Brand's hall on 18 Mar 1886 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>195</sup> He had is pastures swept clean by prairie fire on 23 Mar 1886 at Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>196</sup> He was member of Dodge City Board of Trade on 25 Mar 1886 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>197</sup> He donated \$5 to the Home of the Friendless in Leavenworth on 8 Apr 1886.<sup>198</sup> He applied for a charter for a street railway containing two miles of track with 1 mile on Brdige Street to south side of Arkansas River and the other mile parallel with railroad on 13 May 1886 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>199</sup> He was a stockholder in Monarch Mortgage and Loan Company which was chartered May 21st on 10 Jun 1886 at Dodge City. Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>200</sup> Crawford & Briggs was the name of the new firm which succeeded J. H. Crawford in the grocery business.<sup>201</sup> He purchased lot 35 and # 1/2 lot 33 block 2 for \$925 on 21 Jul 1886 at

Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>202</sup> He received Homestead Certificate No. 1266 Application 2731 filed at Larned KS for lots 1 & 2 and SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 Section 4 Twp 26 Range 26 164 acres on 10 Aug 1886 at Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>203</sup> He purchased N 25 ft lots 21, 22 Chestnut St for \$2000 from Anna L. Robbins on 10 Aug 1886 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>204</sup> He purchased lots 6 and 7 block 47 from the Dodge City Town Co. for \$100 on 10 Aug 1886 at Dodge City, Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>205</sup> He resided in 1887 at Ford Co., Kansas, dealing in groceries, provisions, produce and queensware, also stockman with range South Arkansas River and a breeder of thoroughbred Berkshire hogs having been established in 1878.<sup>206</sup> He purchased land from C. M. Beeson and wife on 12 Jan 1887 at Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>207</sup> He purchased lot 1 block 3 Crawford's Addition from John Russ on 3 Mar 1887 at Dodge City. Ford Co., Kansas.<sup>208</sup> He sold land being lot 2 block 6 Crawford's Addition Dodge City to Daniel D.
