<sup>1</sup> He appeared on the census of 1787 at Hardin County, Virginia.<sup>2</sup> He married Sarah Smith (1446), daughter of Mary (--?--) (1445), on 22 Jan 1788 at Amherst County, Virginia.<sup>3,4</sup> He resided circa 1790 at Garrard County, Kentucky; attended church at Adams' Old Meetinghouse on the east fork of Sugar Creek bordering Buckeye Road.<sup>5</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1790 at Hampshire County, Virginia, as Alexander Dugan, with four whites in the household.<sup>6</sup> He was listed on the tax rolls in 1796 at Madison County, Kentucky.<sup>7</sup> He died before 1799.

**1** Henry<sup>2</sup> Duggins (496)<sup>8</sup> was born on 7 Jan 1789 at on river Dam, Virginia.<sup>9,10,11,12,13</sup> He resided in 1805 at Ohio.<sup>14</sup> He resided in 1806 at Gasper Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>15,16</sup> He was member the 1st church of Eaton called "the old Public Church" circa 1810 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>17</sup> He resided in 1811 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>18</sup> He married Jane Sellers (495), daughter of Nathan A. Sellers (1421) and Sarah Finley (1417), on 16 May 1811 at Ohio.<sup>19,20,21,22,23,24</sup> He served as a private on roll of Capt. David E. Hendrick's Company in 1812.<sup>25</sup> He purchased land being part SW 1/4 S10T7R2 containing 50 acres for \$100 from Nathan Sellers on 5 May 1812 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>26</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1820 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as Henry

Dougan. His household contained 5 males under 5, 1 male 26-45, 1 female 26-45.<sup>27</sup> He purchased land being 5 acre pt SW 1/4 S10T7R2 for \$30 from Nathan Sellers on 17 Dec 1822 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>28</sup> He was listed on the tax rolls between 1827 and 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>29</sup> He purchased land being 160 acres in the SE 1/4 S10T7R2 from Jacob and Catharine Mullendone for \$640 on 29 Nov 1827 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>30</sup> He purchased land being SE 1/4 S10T7R2 containing 160 16/100 acres for \$640 from Jacob Mullendore of Montgomery County Ohio on 29 Nov 1827 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>31</sup> He is head of household on the census of Jul 1830 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as Henry Dugens, with a household containing 3 males 10-15, 2 male 15-20, 1 male 40-50, 1 female 5-10 and 1 female 40-50.<sup>32</sup> He purchased land being Section 2, T20 R13 East of 2nd Prime Meridian, lands lying entirely in present Indiana on 10 Oct 1836.<sup>33,34</sup> He is head of household on the census of Jul 1840 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as Henry Dugans, with a household containing 1 male 10-15, 1 male 20-30, 1 male 50-60, 1 female 15-20, and 1 female 50-60.<sup>35</sup> He purchased land being 5 acres in NE 1/4 S9T7R2 from Andrew Harbison for \$100 on 5 Jan 1847 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>36</sup> He is head of household on the census of 29 Jul 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as Henry Duggins, 61 year old male farmer born Virginia with \$10,000 in real estate. Enumerated with were Nathan Duggins (486) and Jane Sellers (495).<sup>37</sup> He sold land being 3/4 acre portion NW 1/4 S9T7R2, 22 acres in SE 1/4 S4T7R2, 75 acres in SE 1/4 S4T7R2 and 5 acres in NW 1/4 S4T7R2 to Washington P. Duggins for \$2500 on 26 Mar 1852 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>38</sup> He died on 7 Jun 1852 at Preble County, Ohio, at age 63.<sup>39,40,41,42</sup> He was buried at Mound Hill Cemetery, Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>43,44</sup>

**11** Cornelius V.<sup>3</sup> Duggins (498)<sup>45,46,47,48</sup> was born on 17 Mar 1812 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>49,50</sup> He married Elizabeth Monfort (489), daughter of Henry Monfort (6442) and Catherine Montfort (6443), on 5 Jun 1834 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>51,52,53</sup> He was listed on the tax rolls between 1838 and 1842 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>54</sup> He was publisher of Eaton Register between May 1838 and Apr 1841 at Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>55</sup> He sold land being S 1/2 lot 3 Camden to Daniel Paine of Camden for \$250 on 29 Dec 1838 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>56</sup> He sold land being north 1/2 lot 3 in Camden to John H. Johnston for \$150 on 15 Jul 1839 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>57</sup> He purchased land being part of lot 41 and all of lot 42 in Eaton from Robert Haseltine for \$750 on 27 Jan 1840 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>58</sup> He is head of household on the census of Jul 1840 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as Cornelius N. Dugans, with a household containing 1 male under 5, 2 males 20-30, 1 female under 5, 1 female 5-10 and 1 female 20-30. Enumerated with were an unknown witness.<sup>59</sup> He was listed on the tax rolls in 1846 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>60</sup> He was editor of Courier between 1846 and 1850 at New Castle, Henry County, Indiana.<sup>61</sup> He died on 17 Nov 1849 at Newcastle, Henry Co., Indiana, at age 37.<sup>62,63,64</sup> He by heirs of Henry County, Indiana sold land being lot 42 and part of lot 41 Eaton to Oliver Cleveland for \$460 on 21 Apr 1856 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>65</sup>

**111** Celia<sup>4</sup> Duggins (488).<sup>66,67,68</sup> She married William Barnet (6441).<sup>69</sup> She was born after 1838 at Ohio.<sup>70</sup> She was enumerated with Elizabeth Monfort (489) on the census of 23 Jul 1850 at Newcastle, Henry County, Indiana, listed as Celia Duggins a 12 year old female born Ohio.<sup>71</sup> She resided circa 1910 at Cincinnati, Ohio.<sup>72</sup>

**112** Catherine J.<sup>4</sup> Duggins (499)<sup>73,74</sup> was born in 1835 at Ohio.<sup>75,76</sup> She was enumerated with Elizabeth Monfort (489) on the census of 23 Jul 1850 at Newcastle,

Henry County, Indiana, listed as Katherine Duggins a 14 year old female born Ohio.<sup>77</sup> She resided circa 1853 at Henry County, Indiana.<sup>78</sup> She was teacher at Henry County, Indiana.<sup>79</sup> She was enumerated with Elizabeth Monfort (489) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Catharine Duggins a 24 year old female teacher born Ohio.<sup>80</sup> She resided circa 1910 at Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>81</sup> She died in 1927 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>82,83</sup> She was buried at Mound Hill Cemetery, Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>84,85</sup>

**113** Nathan<sup>4</sup> Duggins (486)<sup>86,87</sup> was born in 1840 at Ohio.<sup>88</sup> He was enumerated with Henry Duggins (496) on the census of 29 Jul 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Nathan H. Duggins a 10 year old male born Ohio.<sup>89</sup> He resided circa 1853 at Henry County, Indiana.<sup>90</sup> He was enumerated with Elizabeth Monfort (489) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Nathan H. Duggins a 30 year old male printer born Ohio.<sup>91</sup> He died before 1895.

**114** John F.<sup>4</sup> Duggins (364)<sup>92,93</sup> was born on 28 Jul 1842 at Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>94,95,96</sup> He was enumerated with Elizabeth Monfort (489) on the census of 23 Jul 1850 at Newcastle, Henry County, Indiana, listed as John Duggins a 7 year old male born Ohio.<sup>97</sup> He resided circa 1855 at Henry County, Indiana.<sup>98</sup> He enlisted for service in the Union army in Company C, Seventy-fifth Regiment Ohio Volunteer Infantry, under Captain Harris on 30 Oct 1861.<sup>99,100</sup> He was taken prisoner at Chancellorsville on 2 May 1863 and held for six weeks before being exchanged.<sup>101</sup> He was captured near Lake George, Florida May 1864.<sup>102,103</sup> He was in prison between 19 May 1864 and 26 Nov 1864.<sup>104</sup> He was discharged on 13 Jan 1865 at Columbus, Ohio.<sup>105,106</sup> He was farmer.<sup>107</sup> He was enumerated with Elizabeth Monfort (489) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as John F. Duggins a 27 year old male farmer born Ohio.<sup>108</sup> He married Anna Greer (504), daughter of James Greer (6445), on 18 Nov 1888 at Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>109</sup> He was member Republican party at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>110</sup> He owned one hundred and thirty-four acres of fertile land, on which he carried on a diversified system of farming at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>111</sup> He died in 1928 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>112</sup> He was buried in 1928 at Mound Hill Cemetery, Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>113</sup>

**115** Elizabeth A.<sup>4</sup> Duggins (482)<sup>114,115</sup> was born on 13 May 1847 at Ohio.<sup>116,117</sup> She was enumerated with Elizabeth Monfort (489) on the census of 23 Jul 1850 at Newcastle, Henry County, Indiana, listed as Elizabeth Duggins a 3 year old female born Indiana.<sup>118</sup> She resided circa 1853 at Henry County, Indiana.<sup>119</sup> She died on 21 Nov 1873 at Preble County, Ohio, at age 26.<sup>120,121</sup> She was buried after 21 Nov 1873 at Mound Hill Cemetery, Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>122</sup>

**12** John F.<sup>3</sup> Duggins (503)<sup>123,124,125,126</sup> was born in 1814 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>127</sup> He died before 1852.

**13** Nathan S.<sup>3</sup> Duggins (493)<sup>128,129,130,131,132</sup> was born on 25 Aug 1816 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>133</sup> He died on 25 Aug 1837 at Preble County, Ohio, at age 21.<sup>134,135</sup> He was buried at Mound Hill Cemetery, Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>136,137</sup>

**14** William A.<sup>3</sup> Duggins (502)<sup>138,139,140,141,142</sup> was born on 21 Aug 1818 at Preble County,

Ohio.<sup>143,144,145</sup> He married Harriet Walker (6440) on 20 Oct 1831 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>146,147</sup> He was a boot and shoemaker in 1841 at Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>148</sup> He died on 19 Mar 1850 at Preble County, Ohio, at age 31.<sup>149,150,151</sup> He was buried at Mound Hill Cemetery, Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>152,153,154</sup>

**15** Washington P.<sup>3</sup> Duggins (494)<sup>155,156,157,158,159,160,161</sup> was born on 13 May 1820 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>162,163,164</sup> He married Mary Lugar (490) on 5 Jun 1845 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>165,166,167</sup> He was listed on the tax rolls between 1847 and 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>168</sup> He is head of household on the census of 29 Jul 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as Washington Duggins, a 30 year old white male farmer born Ohio. Enumerated with were Mary Lugar (490), Caroline Duggins (690), and William Minor Duggins (829).<sup>169</sup> He purchased land being 3/4 acre in NW 1/4 S9T7R2, 22 acres in SE 1/4 S4T7R2, 75 acres in SE 1/4 S4T7R2 and 5 acres in NW 1/4 S4T7R2 from Henry Duggins for \$2500 on 26 Mar 1852 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>170</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1860 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as Washington Duggins, a 46 year old male farmer born Ohio with \$5100 in real estate. Enumerated with were Mary Lugar (490), Caroline Duggins (690), Harrison Duggins (1256), Henry Duggins (1257), Phebe Duggins (1258), Mary Duggins (1259), and George Floyd Duggins (1260).<sup>171</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, as Washington Duggins, a 50 year old male farmer born Ohio. Enumerated with were Mary Lugar (490), Caroline Duggins (690), William Minor Duggins (829), Henry Duggins (1257), and Phebe Duggins (1258).<sup>172</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1880 at Preble County, Ohio, as Washington Duggins, a 60 year old male farmer born Ohio. Enumerated with were Mary Lugar (490), Caroline Duggins (690), Harrison Duggins (1256), Henry Duggins (1257), Mary Duggins (1259), George Floyd Duggins (1260), Charles Duggins (1288), Lavina Duggins (1289), and Thomas Duggins (1290).<sup>173</sup> He died on 19 Jun 1896 at Preble County, Ohio, at age 76.<sup>174</sup>

**151** Caroline<sup>4</sup> Duggins (690) was born circa 1847 at Ohio. She was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 29 Jul 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Caroline Duggins a 3 year old white female born Ohio.<sup>175</sup> She was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1860 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Mary Duggins a 13 year old female born Ohio.<sup>176</sup> She was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Callie Duggins a 23 year old female born Ohio.<sup>177</sup> She was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1880 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Callie Duggins a 33 year old female born Ohio.<sup>178</sup>

**152** Harrison<sup>4</sup> Duggins (1256) was born circa 1849 at Ohio. He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1860 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Harrison Duggins a 11 year old male born Ohio.<sup>179</sup>

**153** William Minor<sup>4</sup> Duggins (829) was born circa 1849 at Ohio. He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 29 Jul 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as William M. Duggins a 1 year old white male born Ohio.<sup>180</sup> He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1

Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Minor Duggins a 21 year old male born Ohio.<sup>181</sup> He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1880 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Minor Duggins a 30 year old male carpenter born Ohio.<sup>182</sup> He died in Jan 1896 at Dayton, Ohio.<sup>183</sup> He was buried at Mound Hill Cemetery, Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>184</sup>

**154** Henry<sup>4</sup> Duggins (1257)<sup>185,186</sup> was born circa 1851 at Ohio. He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1860 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Henry Duggins a 9 year old male born Ohio.<sup>187</sup> He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Henry Duggins a 19 year old male born Ohio.<sup>188</sup> He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1880 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Henry Duggins a 28 year old male born Ohio.<sup>189</sup>

**155** Phebe<sup>4</sup> Duggins (1258) was born circa 1854 at Ohio. She was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1860 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Phebe Duggins a 6 year old female born Ohio.<sup>190</sup> She was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Phoebe Duggins a 16 year old female born Ohio.<sup>191</sup>

**156** Mary<sup>4</sup> Duggins (1259) was born circa 1856 at Ohio. She was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1860 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Mary Duggins a 4 year old female born Ohio.<sup>192</sup> She was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1880 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Mary Duggins a 24 year old female born Ohio.<sup>193</sup>

**157** George Floyd<sup>4</sup> Duggins (1260)<sup>194,195,196</sup> was born circa 1859 at Ohio. He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1860 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as George Duggins a 1 year old male born Ohio.<sup>197</sup> He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1880 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as George Duggins a 21 year old male born Ohio.<sup>198</sup> He died on 22 Jul 1891 at Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>199,200</sup> He was buried on 25 Jul 1891 at Mound Hill Cemetery, Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>201</sup>

**158** Charles<sup>4</sup> Duggins (1288) was born circa 1861 at Ohio. He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1880 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Charles Duggins a 19 year old male born Ohio.<sup>202</sup>

**159** Lavina<sup>4</sup> Duggins (1289) was born circa 1864 at Ohio. She was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1880 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Lavina Duggins a 16 year old female born Ohio.<sup>203</sup>

**15A** Thomas<sup>4</sup> Duggins (1290) was born circa 1867 at Ohio.<sup>204</sup> He was enumerated with Washington P. Duggins (494) on the census of 1 Jul 1880 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Thomas Duggins a 12 year old male born Ohio.<sup>205</sup> He died in 1936 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>206</sup> He was buried in 1936 at Mound Hill Cemetery, Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>207</sup>

**15B** (--?--)<sup>4</sup> Duggins (959)<sup>208</sup> was born on 31 Dec 1867 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>209</sup>

**16** Caroline G.<sup>3</sup> Duggins (484)<sup>210,211,212,213,214,215</sup> was born in 1824 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>216</sup> She married Barton Dooley (508) on 5 Oct 1843 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>217,218, 219</sup> She married (--?--) Miller (6360).<sup>220</sup> She died in Jul 1887 at Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>221</sup>

**2** William A.<sup>2</sup> Duggins (497) was born on 19 Nov 1794 at Amherst County, Virginia.<sup>222,223</sup> He resided in 1806 at Ohio.<sup>224</sup> He was member the 1st church of Eaton called "the old Public Church" circa 1810 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>225</sup> He married Sally Neal (500), daughter of Benjamin Neal (1414) and Mary Sellers (1408), on 29 Apr 1819 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>226,227</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1820 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as Wm Dougan, with a household containing 1 male 10-16, 1 male 26-45, and 1 female 16-26.<sup>228</sup> He was listed on the tax rolls between 1827 and 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>229</sup> He purchased land being 80 acres in the W 1/2 NW 1/4 S10T7R2 from Joseph Jr. and Elizabeth Sellers for \$350 on 28 Dec 1827 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>230</sup> He is head of household on the census of Jul 1830 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as William Dugans, with a household containing 2 males 5-10, 1 male 10-15, 1 male 30-40 and 1 female 30-40.<sup>231</sup> He purchased land being 20 acre portion on East side NW 1/4 S10T7R2 and 160 acres being NE 1/4 S10T7R2 from Joseph Sellers and his wife Rachel for \$2300 on 9 Jan 1834 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>232</sup> He is head of household on the census of Jul 1840 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as William Dugans, with a household containing 1 male 10-15, 2 males 15-20, 1 male 40-50, 1 female 5-10 and 1 female 30-40.<sup>233</sup> He purchased land being 40 acre portion SE 1/4 and 127 acre portion NE 1/4 S17T7R2 from George Crane for \$3340 on 17 Mar 1849 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>234</sup> He is head of household on the census of 29 Jul 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as Wm A. Duggins, a 55 year old white male farmer born Virginia with \$13,000 in real estate. Enumerated with were Sally Neal (500), Henry J. Duggins (505), William N. Duggins (485), Sarah D. Duggins (1255), and Sarah Ann Runyan (487).<sup>235</sup> He sold land being part of NW 1/4 S10 T7 R2 described as follows measuring N 42 2/3 rods thence from the southwest corner of said lot 6 rods due East thence 13 1/2 due north to the NE corner of said lot the center of the county road is the West line of said lot to the Board of Education of Washington Township on 3 Sep 1855 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>236</sup> He sold land being same parcel of land deeded by Nelson G. Crawford to W. A. Duggins being the W 1/2 NW 1/4 S14T7R2 containing 77 acres to C. J. White for \$2000 on 18 Jan 1856 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>237</sup> He sold land being 84 66/100 acres in N part SE 1/4 and S part NE 1/4 S17T7R2 to Henry J. Duggins on 10 Mar 1857 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>238</sup> He sold land being 84 66/100 acres in N part SE 1/4 and S pt NE 1/4 S17T7R2 to Benjamin A. Duggins for \$3000 on 10 Mar 1857 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>239</sup> He sold land being 50 36/100 acres in NW 1/4 S31T8R2 to Gideon Miller for \$1600 on 1 Sep 1857 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>240</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1860 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, as William Duggins, a 66 year old male farmer born Virginia. Duggins and his wife Sally on 10 Mar 1857 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>291</sup> He sold land being 84 66/100 acres in N part SE 1/4 and S pt NE 1/4 S17T7R2 to Benjamin A. Duggins for \$3380 on 11 Jun 1857 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>292</sup>

**23** William N.<sup>3</sup> Duggins (485)<sup>293,294,295</sup> was born on 23 Nov 1824 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>296,297,298</sup> He was listed on the tax rolls in 1843 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>299</sup> He was listed on the tax rolls between 1848 and 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio.<sup>300</sup> He married Sarah Ann Runyan (487) on 14 Oct 1849 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>301,302,303</sup> He was enumerated with William A. Duggins (497) on the census of 19 Jul 1850 at Washington Township, Preble County, Ohio, listed as Wm N. Duggins a 25 year old white male born Ohio.<sup>304</sup> He purchased land being 78 acres in NW 1/4 S31 T8 R2 from William Green and his wife Mary Green for \$2200 on 24 Feb 1855 at Preble County, Ohio.<sup>305</sup> He is head of household on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, as William Duggins, a 44 year old male farmer born Ohio. Duggins (485) on the census of 1 Jul 1870 at Preble County, Ohio, listed as Mary Duggins a 14 year old female born Ohio.<sup>334</sup>

**234** Robert<sup>4</sup> Duggins (6368)<sup>335,336,337,338</sup> married Mary (--?--) (6451).<sup>339</sup> He was born circa 1859 at Ohio.<sup>340</sup> He was enumerated with William N.
